Digital Literacy at IKC Wereldwijs

Working on computers is, of course, unimaginable in our society. IKC Wereldwijs also makes extensive use of computers, and not only by the teacher. For example, all children have a Chromebook. On this the children practise with language and reading, for example with Veilig Leren Lezen or line 3. They can also practise arithmetic with arithblobs, Semsom or tafeloefenen.nl. The children can also get on Word and Powerpoint to type up great stories. We use a portal which contains all the software, this is called the COOL portal.

In Parro you can read how your children can also use the school software at home to continue practising.

In the coming period we will also start working on digital literacy. We have set up an ICT working group for this purpose. This working group consists of five teachers and the ICT coordinator, master Niels. Together with the team, they will look at what the school considers important to teach the children in the field of ICT. For example, we already have great ideas about programming lessons, working with robots, but also Artificial Intelligence (AI). For example, how nice would it be to show a hologram of the human body during nature lessons? Another important part is how we make our students digitally proficient and safe.
