## From Intern Supervisor to Quality Coordinator: A Changing Role within More Primary

At More Primary, we are committed to the best quality of education every day. To achieve this, the roles within our schools change with the times. One of these changes is the transition from internal supervisor (IB'er) to quality coordinator (KC). At our school, we see this process up close, as our internal supervisor is currently training to become a quality coordinator.

Whereas an internal supervisor focuses more traditionally on supporting teachers and monitoring the care structure, the quality coordinator has a broader and more multifaceted role. This role has three main pillars: trend analyst, care director and learning coordinator.

**Trend analyst:** As a trend analyst, the quality coordinator is concerned with collecting, analysing and interpreting data. Based on trends and results, strategic choices are made to continuously improve education.

**Care director:** In the role of care director, the quality coordinator monitors the care structure within the school. This involves working with teachers, parents and external partners to ensure that every child receives appropriate support.

**Learning coordinator:** As learning coach, the quality coordinator guides colleagues in their professional development. Through coaching and peer review, this role encourages the team to grow together and get the best out of themselves.
