New language and spelling method

Since this school year, we have been working with the Staal2 method at IKC Wereldwijs primary school. Over the past two years, we, the teachers and children, have researched, learned and discussed together what we think Language should look like at our school. This is our mission and vision:

Vision: Language is learned by doing. As teachers, we are role models. We want the children to learn language not only through instruction, but also by experiencing and applying the language. We provide meaningful education by making the world bigger in addition to what we offer in school through language courses, excursions and guest lessons.

Mission primary school: Language is the basis, language opens the world. When Worldwise children make the transition to secondary education after group 8, they have undergone broad language development. Besides the goals as defined by the SLO, they are able to use language to learn, create, communicate, develop, wonder and enjoy.

Having decided on this, we started looking for a new method that fits in with this as much as possible. That became Staal2. Staal2 is a method with two different parts: spelling & grammar and language.

Spelling and grammar are taught for all moments of writing. The children learn to apply spelling through the clear structure of the language. The method of teaching is the same in all classes, creating a continuous, constructive line. In the beginning, it certainly took some getting used to, but now the children already manage very well. In this method, daily dictation and instruction is the most important part of the lesson. After that, the teacher checks which children still need to complete certain tasks in the workbook to master the material. So the children do not complete all the assignments in the workbook.

Language is taught on the basis of a theme. The children first build a vocabulary that gives them the language to talk about the theme. The theme starts with a riddle 'The grej of Staal' to the final product. Texts on the theme make the children curious and enrich their knowledge about the world. Constantly, the children are engaged in different domains of language and gain new language impressions. The children get a grip on the subject and work towards their final product. That is, for example, a publication and/or presentation. You will see a lot about this final product in Parro. In language, too, teachers make choices about what the children really need. So again, you will see that some assignments or lessons are not completed.





Poëtsbus

The Poëtsbus is on its way to the Wereldwijs!

On Monday 24 February, Tuesday 25 February, Monday 3 March and Tuesday 4 March, the Poëtsbus will park its converted American school bus in front of the doors of IKC Wereldwijs. Youth dental care Poëtsbus focuses on preventing cavities among North Holland's youth. This is badly needed, because more than half of the children's teeth in North Holland have cavities!

The Poëtsbus is not a replacement for the dentist but an addition to prevention. The aim of this project is to create awareness about one's own teeth. In the Poëtsbus, children learn specifically about their own teeth and how best to care for them.

In the basic insurance, children up to the age of 18 are fully insured for both the Poëtsbus and the dentist. The activities of the Poëtsbus are reimbursed by your health insurer and do not come off the deductible.

On Monday 3 February, all groups will receive a classroom lesson and children from groups 1 to 8 will receive a letter addressed to the parent with a detailed introduction. The consent forms will be collected on Monday 10 February, these can also be handed in later. Only the children who have received permission will be invited to the bus.

Gemotiveerde en betrokken ouders voor de Medezeggenschapsraad

IKC Wereldwijs is op zoek naar gemotiveerde ouders die mee willen denken over hoe we IKC Wereldwijs nog meer kunnen verbeteren.

Wat is een Medezeggenschapsraad (MR)?

Iedere school heeft een MR, de MR praat mee over allerlei onderwerpen die te maken hebben met de school en het onderwijs.

Een MR bestaat altijd uit ouders en personeel.

Welke bevoegdheden heeft een MR? De MR heeft een belangrijke positie binnen de school. Bij veel beslissingen die het bestuur of de directie neemt, is het verplicht om ouders en het personeel te raadplegen. Dit gebeurt via de MR en dit is vastgelegd in de Wet Medezeggenschap op Scholen (WMS). Er zijn verschillende soorten beslissingen, zoals:

- waarover de MR advies geeft,
- waarvoor van de MR instemming is vereist en
- waarover de directie alleen de MR hoeft te informeren.

De MR van IKC Wereldwijs

Deze bestaat in het mooiste scenario uit drie personeelsleden en drie ouders. Gezamenlijk werken wij mee aan het verbeteren van de school en het onderwijs.

Wat verwachten wij van u?

- Betrokkenheid bij de kwaliteit van IKC Wereldwijs en het onderwijs.
- Interesse in schoolbeleid en schoolregels.
- Affiniteit met vergaderen en lezen van stukken.
- Aanwezigheid bij de MR-vergaderingen (6 keer per schooljaar).
- Een kritische én open houding.
- Goed in de Nederlandse of Engelse taal verstaanbaar maken.

Wat levert het u op?

Zitting nemen in de MR is voor ouders vrijwilligerswerk. U krijgt meer inzicht in het onderwijs en de organisatie van de school van uw kind(eren). Ook doet u ervaring op met het bedenken en controleren van het beleid.

MR-leden hebben recht op scholing. Bijvoorbeeld over de regels en de praktijk van medezeggenschap, onderhandelen, vergadertechnieken en strategie. Zo heeft u ook persoonlijk profijt van extra training en vaardigheden.
