Introductions:

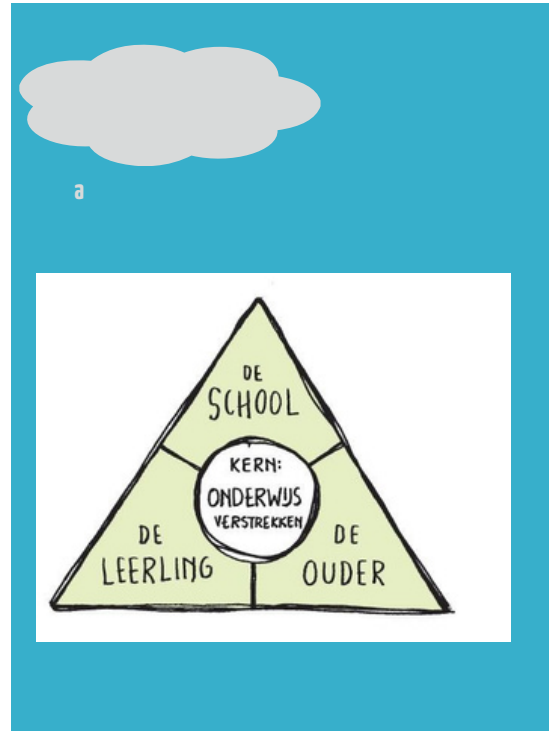
