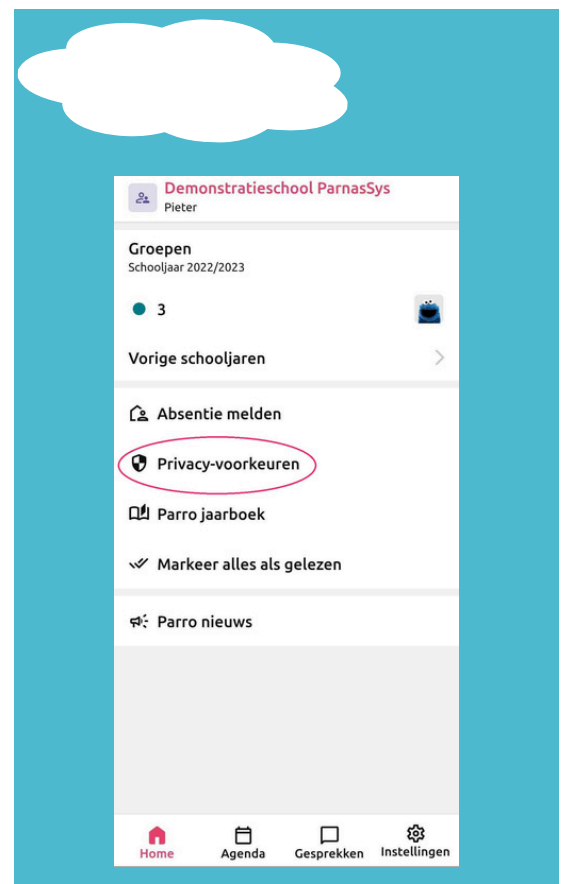
Privacy preferences Parro app

Until Monday 4 November, you can submit or change your privacy preferences in the Parro app.

How do I change privacy preferences?

You can view and change your privacy preferences according to the following steps:

1. Go to the Home page in the app.
2. Tap Privacy preferences (under groups).
3. Select the child for whom you want to view or change preferences.
4. Here you will see the current privacy preferences.
5. Behind each preference, choose whether or not to allow it using the drop-down menu. You can also choose to allow or disallow everything at once using the Allow all option.
6. Under the conditions, click the Save button. The privacy preferences are automatically updated and adopted in ParnasSys.
7. After 4 November, you can always change your preferences. You can then send a Parro message to your child's teacher.
